



WHAT IS A HAZARDOUS LOCATION?

A hazardous location is an area or environment where flammable liquids, gases or vapors, and/or combustible dusts exist in sufficient enough quantities to produce an explosion or fire.

WHAT MAKES A LIGHT INTRINSICALLY SAFE?

An Intrinsically Safe light is a light that will not cause ignition of hazardous material.

It is important to know which **CLASS** and **DIVISION** your workplace is in.



CLASS

Categorizes the various hazardous materials that may be present in a work space.



DIVISIONS

The probability of hazardous material being present in the surrounding area.
